Assessment Day Two

Assessment day two will be a whole day session and involves a series of computer-based tests which provide us with more information on some of the key attributes and aptitudes of successful Air Traffic Controllers. These assessments include the First European Air Traffic Control Selection Test Battery (FEAST) and also some NATS assessments.

FEAST includes a number of sub-tests, all of which were specially developed to assess applicants for Air Traffic Control training. The NATS computer assessments are a range of tests which assess abilities which are important for success in the role. All of the assessment day two tests will require you to concentrate for periods of time, and they can be quite demanding. It is therefore important that you only attend the session if you are feeling fit and well rested.

There will be a test administrator to provide full instructions for all of these tests, and you have the opportunity to practice some of the tasks and tests before you start. You will also be given breaks throughout the day, and NATS will of course provide lunch! If there is anything you do not understand at any point, please just ask.
